Eligibility	M.Sc. Chemistry	- The candidate must have secured 40% marks in the aggregate and studied Chemistry securing 50% marks in this subject at B.Sc. level and studied Mathematics at 10+2 or Pre-University level.
	M.Sc. Botany	- B.Sc. Degree with 40% marks in aggregate of all the subjects and 50% marks in Botany in qualifying examinations.
	M.Sc. Microbiology	- B.Sc. Degree with 50% marks (45% for SC/ST) in all the three optional individually and in aggregate. Chemistry/Biochemistry is a compulsory optional subject required. The other two optionals required are any two from the following: (a) Microbiology; (b) Bio-technology; (c) Botany; (d) Applied Botany; (e) Zoology; (f) Applied Zoology; (g) Environmental Science; (h) Genetics; (i) Applied Genetics; (j) Sericulture; (k) Home Science; (l) Life Sciences and (m) Biological Sciences.
	M.Sc. (Com. Science)	- The candidate with B.Sc. (Computer Science) or BCA with at least 50% aggregate marks of all optional subjects (throughout 3 years of B.Sc./BCA Course).
	M.Sc. Physics	- 50% Marks in UG with Physics major.
	M.A. English	- Candidate with B.A./B.Sc. or B.Com. Degree are also eligible to apply provided that have scored 55% in the English Language.
	M.A. Political Science	- Graduates who have scored 40% of all subjects and 50% marks in Political Science or Public Administration at their Bachelor's Degree level.
	M.A. Economics	- Graduates who have scored 40% of all subjects and 50% marks in Economics at their Bachelor's Degree level.
	M.S.W.	- A Bachelor's Degree in any subject of a recognized university with a minimum of 50% marks with any of the following subjects: Social work, Anthropology, Economics, Political Science, Public Administration, History, Philosophy or a Degree with 3 years experience in Social Work in a recognized institution.
	M.S. (Communication)	a) Journalism Graduates : Candidates who have a second class Bachelor's Degree with 50% of aggregate in all examinations of the degree in optional subjects of Journalism. b) Non-Journalism Graduates : Candidates who have passed the Bachelor's Degree examination from any recognised University with 50% marks in aggregate of all subjects including languages are eligible.
