SPECIAL FAST TRACK SUPPLEMENTARY FOUNDATION COURSE


Based on the circular on exams from the UGC and Government of Karnataka the college has decided to conduct special fast track supplementary examination for Foundation Courses that were to be held in May 2020.

The **examination** will be held **ONLINE** on the **29th of August 2020** for **Indian Constitution, Computer Fundamentals & Environmental Studies and Civic sense.**

The **supplementary candidates for Science & Culture and Culture, Diversity & Society will be intimated about the assignments shortly, which will need to be submitted on or before 29th of August 2020 (This is meant only for those who have registered for examination only).**

Online exam: Rules and requirements

- This exam is meant only for the **SUPPLEMENTARY** students **who have already applied for the examination.**
- Students who had attendance shortage in the foundation course should have attended the classes (held in month of June and July) failing which they would not be allowed to take up the examination. Registration for the course and exam should have been completed.
- Students who did not have attendance shortage in the particular foundation course but failed or did not attend the regular foundation course exam, can however directly attend the exam provided they have registered for the same.
- Some students have pending fee payment dues which need to be made (details will be intimated to the candidates shortly), failing which the results of the foundation course will be withheld even if exam is taken.
- The Pattern of question paper for the Special fast track foundation course examinations will be MCQ based with 40 questions of 1 mark each. The examination will be for One-hour duration. The Syllabus will be the entire syllabus inclusive of self-study topics.
- The Exam time table will be notified on the college website.
- All students taking up the exam are required to have the following: A smart phone / tablet/ laptop with an uninterrupted internet of 1.5 hours for each paper.
- The online exam will be offered to the student on a specific platform which requires uninterrupted internet. Students must make their own arrangements for all the requirements.
