It is hereby notified that the 1st, 3rd and 5th semester UG and 1st and 3rd semester PG regular and supplementary examinations will commence from the 17th of January 2022.

Examinations will be conducted **offline** in the college. The detailed timetable is put up on the college website , student's group and examination notice board.

Hall tickets for the Regular Students:

Hall tickets will be released at 1 pm on the 12th of January 2022 for the eligible candidates.

FOR SUPPLEMENTARY CANDIDATES ONLY

Students can register for supplementary examinations for odd semester courses from 10 am on the 17th of December 2021 through the Linways portal. The last date to apply for the supplementary examination is **5pm on the 31st December 2021.**

Issues related to registration in the Linways portal and payment of fees, if any, shall be addressed to the IT cell. (it@sjc.ac.in)

Eligibility: Students whose registration number starts with 17 and above are eligible to apply for the undergraduate supplementary examination. Students whose registration number starts with 18 and above are eligible to apply for the Postgraduate supplementary examination.

Special Cases:

a)Additional academic year candidates: UG students whose registration number starts with 16 and PG students whose registration number starts with 17 and who had requested for the additional academic year to complete the programme and got the approval for the same must register for the supplementary examination **offline** in the office of the COE and pay the examination fees.

b)One last chance candidates: UG and PG students who had registered for one last chance to complete the programme and got the approval for the same may register for the supplementary examination **offline** in the office of the COE.

c)CA improvement candidates : Candidates who had registered for the CA improvement of courses must apply for the supplementary examinations for the same courses. Such candidates must register for the supplementary examination **offline** in the office of the COE. All those who had applied for one last chance or under additional academic year need not have to apply again for the supplementary examination.

Candidates under category a,b and c shall submit the required application forms and pay the examination fees between 17th of December to 31st of December 2021 on all working days from 11am to 3pm (with a break between 1 & 2 due to the ongoing mid semester test). Please note that 23, 24, 25, 26 and 27 of December 2021 are holidays. Payment must be made online using the QR code available in the examination section. Kindly submit the copies of all marks cards for those semester(s) in which supplementary examinations are to be written. A recent passport size photograph must be affixed on the hall ticket form. Candidates must write the examination in the current syllabus.

Term paper: Students who had to submit the Term paper may register for the supplementary examination online from 10 am on the 20th of December 2021 through the Linways portal. **The last date to apply for the supplementary examination is 5pm on the 31st December 2021. Also the soft copy of the Termpaper must be sent to the guides latest by 5pm on the 31st of January 2022.** Term paper will not be evaluated, if the student failed to submit it before the deadline.

IGNITORS: All UG and PG students who have passed out but are yet to

complete Ignitors are hereby directed to send an email to sjignitors2020@gmail.com on or before 5 pm on the 31st of December 2021.

Practical Supplementary Examination:

Practical supplementary examinations for the first semester UG courses will be conducted after the theory examinations for the same.

Hall tickets for the supplementary examinations:

Hall tickets will be released on the 10th of January 2022 for those who have registered and paid the fee for the supplementary examination. Those who had applied offline must collect the hall ticket from the Examination section on the 10th of January 2022 from 10am-3pm.

Syllabus for the supplementary examination:

As per the rules of the college, if a syllabus has been changed for a course, (indicated by the last two digits in the code number) the candidate will get two additional chances to write the examination in the old syllabus. (This is calculated from the year in which the syllabus was changed). If the course was discontinued from the given semester, the candidate will get three additional chances to write the examination in the old syllabus. For some special cases, one more chance in the old syllabus will be given and the details will be posted on the college website in the first week of January.

One subject shortage candidates of 1st semester & 3rd semester

All candidates denied a hall ticket for one subject due to the shortage in attendance for a given course, in the first semester in 2018-19 & 19-20 and third semester in 2019-20 are allowed to write the examination without attending the classes for the same. This is due to the implementation of the NEP. First semester UG supplementary examination will be conducted separately and it starts from the 25th January 2022.
