This violates the University rule and was referred to the malpractice prevention committee for further action. The committee in turn has recommended canceling that paper as per the rule and the VC has approved the same. Students are hereby advised not to reveal their identity by writing any extra note(s) or their registration number in the semester examination theory answer sheet. Anyone violating this rule will be booked for malpractice in the upcoming examinations also.
