<u>Ref: One-time chance for all autonomous batch students who have exhausted all permitted</u> <u>chances to complete the programme.</u>

(UG 2005 to 2015 & PG 2005 to 2016 batches)

(Registration for the Even semester examination of 2021-22)

As per the UGC guidelines, all UG students must complete the programme within 5 years and PG students within 4 years. The duration is calculated from the date of the first entry to the respective programme in the college.

The college was receiving representations from the old students who had exhausted all chances to complete the programme, to give an additional chance. The academic council 2021, took a humanitarian stand and allowed all previous batch students of autonomous batches (since 2005) to appear for the odd and even semester examinations in the academic year 2021-22.

This registration is only for the even semester examinations of the academic year 2021-22. Students seeking a one-time chance must write the examinations in the new syllabus and the mode of examination and the pattern of question paper will be the same as that for the regular candidates. Kindly write to the HODs regarding the course code number, title and the syllabus of the paper(s) to be written.

Students who were ineligible to write the examination due to various reasons and status remain the same are not allowed to write the one-time chance examination.

Those candidates who want to apply for the onetime chance must

(i)Fill out the registration form and send it to <u>coeoffice@sjc.ac.in</u> along with the scanned copy of the marks statement for the semester(s) in which there is back paper.

(ii)Fill out the Google form after the discussion with the HODs

(iii)Apply for the supplementary examination, April 2022 (to be conducted in July-August 2022) after the notification.
